
All returned with loads to joyful learning and fond memories.







CHEESE GARLIC BREAD RECIPE BY MEERA MENON- GRADE V

Ingredients

Bread - 2 Slices Mozzarella cheese − ½ cup Butter — 4 Tea spoons

Garlic - 2 pods

Oregano Seasoning

Method of Preparation:

- 1. Slice the bread into halves.
- 2. Peel and finely chop the garlic.
- 3. Add garlic to butter and mix well.
- 4. Spread butter uniformly on bread.
- 5. Sprinkle oregano seasoning on the buttered bread.
- 6. Top with shredded mozzarella cheese.
- 7. Pre-heat the oven to 180°C.
- 8. Place bread slice on grill stand or glass plate.
- 9. Place in oven and bake for 5 to 10 minutes at 180°C until cheese gets melted.
- 10. Take out of the oven and serve!
